The next InterClub to Burns on Sept 30th completes our round robin. This has been a great year visiting each club twice!



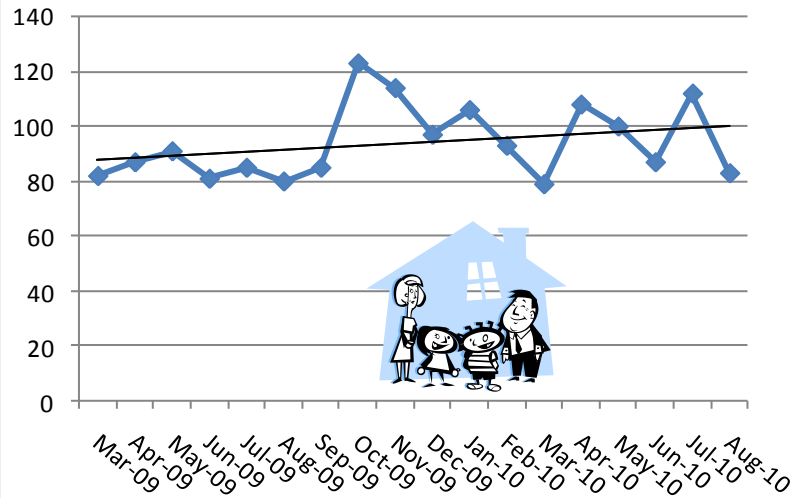

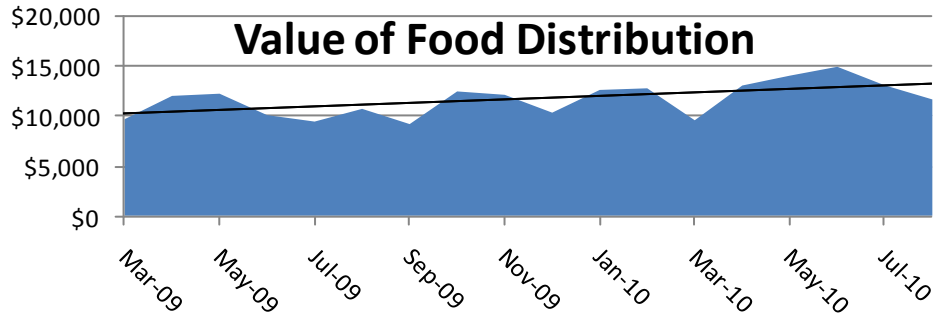

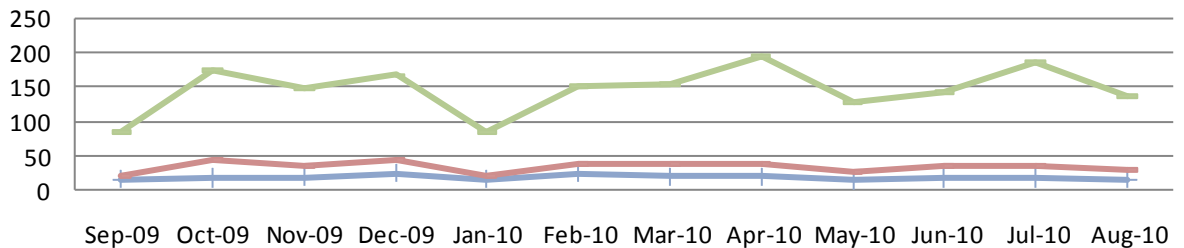


## Value of Food Distribution
